Brief Report of Selection of CPIC Members in the Pilot Communities on the Project "Gender Inequality and Rural Women's Health in Post-COVID-19 Nigeria: Towards Inclusive and Sustainable Rural Women's Health in Nigeria"

## Introduction

Community participation in project implementation increases local ownership of projects and help ensure project sustainability. In line with this, CPED has been using participatory approach in the implementation of projects, especially in rural communities. This approach is also being adopted and used by CPED project team in the implementation of the current project. The project design allows for beneficiaries to be part of the implementation process. Consequently, the project team through a selection process established a community-based committee in each of the target pilot communities. This was done through mobilization and interaction with existing viable female only social groups in the selected pilot communities and thereafter, their leaders, were brought together to form community group refer to in this project as Community Project Implementation Committee (CPIC). The CPIC members selected have the passion to carry out what is required of the project at the community level and is comprised of both matured women and young women who are vibrant and articulate. The CPIC members were selected from the six pilot communities namely Ididigba-Usugbenu (Esan Central), Idoko (Etsako East) and Ikoha (Ovia Southwest) in Edo state as well as Alifekede (Ika South), Akpata (Ethiope East) and Irri (Isoko South) in Delta state.
